Chobe National Park 3 nights

On arrival in Kasane you will be met by your guide and transferred to the Chobe National Park. The park is the second largest in Botswana (11,700 sq km) and named after the river Chobe that forms the northern boundary of the park. The Chobe River support one of the largest concentrations of elephant found anywhere in Africa and it is not uncommon to encounter herds in excess of a hundred. The elephants leave the river for the southern region of the park during the rainy season (December to March) at the time when food and water is freely available inland. Chobe is also famous for it's huge herds of buffalo, the Chobe bushbuck, and for being the southern-most point where puku can be seen. The river serves as the main water source for the wildlife and birdlife in the area.

The next 3 days will be spent game driving along the incredible Chobe River flood plain and experiencing an abundance of wildlife.

On one of the days guests can be taken on an optional extra 3 hour lunch time cruise of the Chobe River. This can be booked in advanced through us.

Included:

- All National Park fees
- Type of accommodation
 - The accommodation is in spacious insect proof walk-in tents with gauze-covered windows.
 - The lighting inside the tents is bright enough to read by.
 - The ablutions are en-suite, consisting of an ash long drop toilet and hot water bucket showers.
- Meals and Drinks
 - Three substantial meals per day are served, between planned safari activities.
 - Menus of fresh produce change every day and vegetarian or special diets can be catered for by prior arrangement.
 - BAR will be charged on consumption

Type of Vehicles

The vehicles used on the safari are custom fitted 4 x 4 vehicles seating 8 people excluding the guide.
